### The Caribbean ICT Roadshow

The Government of Grenada will be hosting the Caribbean Telecommunications Union's (CTU) **Caribbean ICT Roadshow** from 16<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>h</sup> May, 2011. The Roadshow is designed to educate and raise public awareness on the transformative power of information and communication technologies (ICT) to foster national development and transform societies and economies. The initiative advocates the need for innovation when incorporating ICT tools in order to realize the full potential of the technologies. The Theme of the Roadshow is "Harnessing the Power of Innovation – The engine for ICT-enabled development"

ICT has become a significant element of the development strategy for nation building in the Caribbean. ICT presents opportunities to strengthen and develop more efficient and productive governance and business systems; to define and develop new types of jobs and business; to build the capacity of citizens; and to enhance Puerto Rico's global competitiveness.

Grenada is 15<sup>th</sup> country to benefit from the Roadshow initiative and this edition of the Roadshow, branded "TEXPO" will feature:
