The Caribbean ICT Roadshow

The Government of Grenada will be hosting the Caribbean Telecommunications Union's (CTU) **Caribbean ICT Roadshow** from 16th to 19^h May, 2011. The Roadshow is designed to educate and raise public awareness on the transformative power of information and communication technologies (ICT) to foster national development and transform societies and economies. The initiative advocates the need for innovation when incorporating ICT tools in order to realize the full potential of the technologies. The Theme of the Roadshow is "Harnessing the Power of Innovation – The engine for ICT-enabled development"
